Review various repair bids for Community Hall:

Bids from Alex Erickson Construction were reviewed. Consensus is to have Alex come to the next City Council meeting for further discussion on the bids submitted for the various work.

Discussion on the new Pie Shack and other construction at Spring Lake Park.

Consensus is to have Solid Bottom Septic pump the Port-A-Johns. Schedule will be every other week in June, and then in July go every week until mid-August, and then mid-August through September go every other week.

Discussion on the Vleck Memorial Park – Members of the LIC are gathering new ideas for perennials for the park, with assistance from the staff at Bergesen Nursery.
