

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW IN THE VILLAGE OF LENGBY.

The Village Council of Lengby, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. No person under the age of 16 years shall be or loiter upon any of the public streets, alleys or public grounds, or in any public place, or upon any vacant premises within the Village, between the hours of 10:00 o'clock P.M. and 5:00 o'clock A.M., unless accompanied by a parent or some adult person placed in charge of such child by his or her parent, or unless because of an emergency.


Section 2. No parent or other person having the care and custody of a child under the age of 16 years shall knowingly permit such child to violate the provisions of Section 1 herein.

Section 3. No person owning, operating or in charge of any public place shall knowingly permit any child under the age of 16 years to remain in such public place between the hours of 10:00 o'clock P.M. and 5:00 o'clock A.M., except as permitted under the provisions of Section 1 herein.

Section 4. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
