## Ordinance Number Three

Relating to Assaults, Breaches of the Peace, and Disorderly Conduct

The Village Council of the Village of Lengby do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. Any person who shall commit an assault upon any other person or persons within the Corporate Limits of said Village, or who shall unlawfully engage in any fight, battery, or affray within said Village shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Any person who shall be found in a state of open or riotous Drunkenness or Intoxication in any street or public place within said Village shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Any person who shall appear in any street, public or enclosed place in said Village in a state of nudity, or shall make any lewd or indecent exposure of his or her person, or be guilty of any obscene or filthy act, or of any lewd or indecent language or behavior, or shall exhibit any lewd, indecent or immoral pictures, books or other things, or shall stand any stallion, bull, jack or other animal for Breeding purposes in any open or unenclosed place to the annoyance of the Public, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 4. Any person who shall make, aid, countenance or assist in making any noise, riot or disturbance or improper diversion, and all persons who shall collect in bodies or crowds in said Village for unlawfull purposes, or to the annoyance or disturbance of the Citizens of Travelers, or to the obstruction of the streets or sidewalks shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 5. No person shall upon any street or alley in said village engage in any game of baseball, football, or other game, or throw any stones or missiles to the annoyance of the public or so as to endanger or damage property in said Village.

Section 6. Any person who shall unnecessarily, cruelly or wantonly abuse or neglect any dumb animal in said Village shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 7. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance and who shall be convicted therefor shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on such conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars and the cost of Prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, shall be im-

imprisoned until said fine and costs be paid, not exceeding ninety days.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
