Call to Order / Determine Quorum

Ordinances:

Brief discussion on the camper ordinance.

Road Plan Discussion:

The grant application that was submitted by Sean McKnight was denied; due to the fact that no County Roads would be impacted by the construction.

Other City Business:

Gordon Omodt, lives out on road on north side of Railroad Tracks. Big pothole on the road which is still within city limits. Brian did look at it. Should be filled with gravel. Possible solution is to get crushed

concrete, some dumped on pothole, and then some sumped on the lake road; possibly two loads. 1st by Godtland; 2nd by Walker to get 2 loads of crushed concrete. Motion carried.

No update has been received on the new Fishing Pier.

Swim platform. Kids have been pulling on the carpet. Synthetic decking. Suggestion is to talk to Josh Pearson and see if he would be willing to price it out and work on it.
