ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING THE MINNESOTA HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATION ACTS BY REFERENCE.

The Village Council of Lengby, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. The regulatory provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Ch. 168, 169, 171, 100.29 Subd. 5, 340.035 and 340.731, as amended, are hereby adopted as a traffic ordinance regulating the use of highways, streets, alleys and other lands within the Village of Lengby, Minnesota. Any person thus violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of such an offense and shall be punsihed by such penalty as is prescribed by such statutes.

Section 2. Unreasonable acceleration of any motor vehicle on any public or private road or way within the Village of Lengby, Minnesota, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and is prohibited. Unreasonable acceleration of a motor vehicle is hereby defined as acceleration without apparent reason, and accomplished in such manner as to cause squealing or screeching sounds by the tires or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of said vehicle or both. Prima facie evadence of such unnecessary and unreasonable acceleration shall be squealing or screeching sounds emitted by the tires or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of said vehicle or both. Any person violating any provision of this section shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
