

ORDINANCE NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF SPRING LAKE PARK

The Village Council of Lengby, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. No person shall be or loiter in or upon the Spring Lake Park premises between the hours of 11 o'clock p.m. and 5 o'clock a.m.

Section 2. No person shall possess or consume any alcoholic beverages within the Spring Lake Park.

Section 3. No person shall throw or deposit trash, garbage or debris within the Spring Lake Park, except in containers provided therefor by the Village.

Section 4. No person shall ignite, manage or maintain any fire within the Spring Lake Park other than in the fireplaces provided therefor.

Section 5. No person shall stop or park any motor vehicle upon the traveled portion of the roadway in Spring Lake Park.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
