## Amendment to Ordinance 29

Section 6. "Hours of Operation"

The sentence previously reading, "No "off-sale" shall be made on New Year's Day, January 1; Independence Day, July 4; Thanksgiving Day; or Christmas Day, December 25. "shall now be read as, "No off-sale shall be made on Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day (December 25)."

Off-sale will be allowed on New Year's Day (January 1) and Independence Day (July 4) unless these holidays fall on a Sunday.

This amendment shall be effective upon its passage and publication.

## **ORDINANCE NO 29.1**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 29, ADOPTED ON MARCH 1, 1976, AND TITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN THE CITY OF LENGBY, POLK COUNTY, MINNESOTA."

The City Council of Lengby ordains:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 29 adopted on March 1, 1976, and titled, "An ordinance regulating the sale of intoxicating liquor in the city of Lengby, Polk County, Minnesota." is amended to read:

## Section 2. 6. HOURS OF OPERATION

No "on-sale" shall be made between the hours of one a.m. and eight a.m. on any weekday. No "on-sale" shall be made between the hours of one a.m. and four p.m. of Thanksgiving Day. No "on-sale" shall be made after eight p.m. on Christmas Eve Day. No "on-sale" shall be made before four p.m. on Christmas Day. No "off-sale" shall be made on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day, December 25. No "off-sale" shall be made after eight p.m. on Christmas Eve Day.

No licensee shall permit any person other than a bona fide employee of said licensee to remain on the licensed premises more than one-half hour after legal sales of intoxicating liquor have closed.

No licensee shall permit any person to keep or possess "off-sale" goods on the licensed premises more than one-quarter hour after legal "off-sales" have closed.

Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
