ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING DRINKING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

The City of Lengby, Polk County, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION 1. DRINKING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

No person shall drink intoxicating liquor on any public property, streets, sidewalks, or around public buildings.

SECTION 2. DRUNKENESS

No person shall be in a state of open or riotous drunkenness or intoxication in any street or public place.

SECTION 3. DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Every peace officer shall arrest any person found committing any act forbidden by this ordinance and make complaint against him.

SECTION 4. PENALTIES

Violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and penalties for conviction of any of these provisions shall be as provided under state law.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
